Thanks to the generosity of our Monthly Giving Club, St. Francis Memorial Hospital has been able to perform a critical upgrade to its laboratory; one that integrates the lab with an information sharing system which can access lab results and critical patient information quickly and safely with other labs and hospitals.

The lab plays a vital role across the entire continuum of healthcare. Lab results directly impact clinical decision-making by providing physicians, nurses and other healthcare providers with important information needed for the prevention, diagnosis, treatment and management of disease.

This upgrade took two years to complete. **Our 168 loyal donors** who contribute either monthly or through an annual commitment to the St. Francis Circle Giving Club can be proud to say that they helped make this upgrade happen. In 2022, our Circle Giving Club, which includes monthly and annual donors, **raised an incredible \$73,000!**

Did You Know The laboratory at St. Francis Memorial Hospital offers a number of critical services for both patients in the emergency department and outpatients. During the fiscal year of April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023:

- 1,022 outpatients received bloodwork
- -M- 912 electrocardiograms were conducted
 - 148 holter monitors were used

Did you know that the St. Francis Circle Giving Club helped purchase a vital upgrade to the laboratory's information sharing system over a two year period? This upgrade, which went live in November 2022, integrates seamlessly with EPIC - the hospital's information sharing system.

Michael McConnell is the site laboratory operations manager with the Eastern Ontario Regional Laboratory Association. He says this new upgrade means faster turnaround time for results and added efficiencies for the lab staff.

"It's a great system," he said.
